


The past year was an exciting year for the Parsons Area Community Foundation.

We started the year with our annual granting season. The number of organizations applying for grants has continued to grow. In the spring of 2023, the Community Foundation granted approximately \$305,000 in designated, unrestricted and field of interest funds to deserving charitable and governmental organizations in our area. We are truly grateful to these organizations for the impact they have on members of our communities. We are honored to be able to help them achieve their goals.

The summer saw the completion of the renovation project of our offices at 1810 Main Street. In the fall we held an open house to share the project with the community. We enjoyed a wonderful evening of hosting tours and visiting with our friends and neighbors.

Agency Funds

Local agencies may place funds with the Parsons Area Community Foundation for growth and investment. Fund agreements state the purpose of the fund and whether the organization will have access to both income and principal, or only take distributions from earnings on the principal. Endowed funds provide the agency with an ongoing annual stream of income and are included in the Giving Tuesday Match Day event held annually on the Tuesday following Thanksgiving.

It involves a contract between a donor and the community foundation with the donor transferring cash or property to the foundation in exchange for a partial tax deduction and a lifetime stream of annual income. When the donor passes, the community foundation receives the balance of the gift.
